

Hack X LBEF: Rules and Regulations For participation

Event Details

- **Event Date:** January 4 (Presentation) and January 11 (Coding Phase)
 - **Duration:** 48 hours
 - **Location:** LBEF E-Block
 - Participants must attend the entire event and arrive on time (details will be sent via email).
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Team Requirements

- **Team Composition:** Teams are fixed after the event begins. Changes result in disqualification.
 - **Venue Rules:**
 - Participants must stay within the designated venue.
 - Required materials should be ready before the event starts.
 - During breaks, at least 1 member (3-person teams) or 2 members (5-person teams) must remain present.
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Project Development

- All projects must be original and created during the event.
- Use of pre-existing code is not allowed unless it is pre-approved open-source.
- Intellectual property rights belong to the participants but must comply with licensing rules.

Submission Guidelines:

- Submit projects via the designated platform; late submissions will not be accepted.
- Documentation is mandatory.

Presentation Protocol:

- Teams have 5 minutes to present their project, followed by 2 minutes of Q&A with judges.
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Judging Criteria

- Judging decisions are final and cannot be appealed.
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Code of Conduct

- Maintain professionalism.
 - Harassment or discrimination is strictly prohibited and will lead to disqualification.
 - Keep team strategies confidential.
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Withdrawal and Penalties

- **Penalty Amount:** Rs. 10,000 for:
 - Withdrawal after registration confirmation.
 - Failure to attend (“no-show”).
 - Leaving before the event concludes.
 - Incomplete team attendance.

Exemptions:

- Valid reasons include medical emergencies, family deaths, natural disasters, or government obligations (with proper documentation).

Non-Transferable Registration:

- Registrations are personal and cannot be transferred or assigned.
 - Attempting to transfer registration will result in penalties and disqualification.
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Intellectual Property and Media

- Participants retain ownership of their projects.
 - Organizers may showcase projects with proper credit.
 - By participating, you consent to the use of event media (photos/videos) for promotional purposes.
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Health and Safety

- Follow venue safety protocols. Reckless behavior leads to disqualification.
 - Technical support will be available, but no extensions will be provided unless officially announced.

Hack X LBEF: Organizers' Rules and Responsibilities

Confidentiality

- Sensitive information, such as sponsor agreements or judging criteria, must remain strictly confidential.

Participation Restrictions

- Organizers cannot participate in the hackathon competition.
- To participate, an organizer must **resign from the organizing team** before the event begins.

Financial Accountability

- Misuse of funds or failure to document expenses will result in **removal from the team** and may lead to legal action.

Marketing Approval

- All public-facing materials (e.g., posters, social media posts) must be approved by the **core organizing team** before publication.

Leadership

- Leadership roles may be reassigned based on feedback from the organizing committee.
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
